Dear Competitor,

Hello and welcome to the 3rd round of the 2018 Eagle Trailers and Campers SA MX Championship. Please find the information required for the event.

This event is an OPEN meeting and is open to **Senior & Junior National Licence Holders and One Event National Licences Only**. Recreational licences are **ONLY VALID** for the 50cc Demonstration.

This event will be run as per the 2018 MoMS, the Supplementary Regulations and these Final Instructions.

THE ONUS IS ON YOU TO ensure that your licence is current, clear of any suspension, and of the correct endorsement.

Venue information:

- The track is located at 55 Charles Well Road, Keith. Please enter via the main gate.
- Camping is permitted at the venue – showers and facilities are available. There are some powered areas. \$10.00 per camp site.
- 10pm curfew both nights. The main generator will be turned off at this time.
- Please ensure all areas are cleaned up – use the bins provided or take your rubbish with you.
- STRICTLY NO Alcohol in the pit area. Anyone camping at the venue must ensure that all alcohol is put away during the meeting.
- No fires are permitted during the meeting.
- Pit tents must be secured properly.
- Fuel must be in appropriate containers.
- No open-toed shoes.
- Pushbikes are to be put away during the meeting.
- Dogs are not allowed on the premises (exception of Human Aid dogs).
- Bikes are to be washed in the designated wash bay area only.
- No pillion passengers at any time.
- Helmets must be worn when a motorcycle is being ridden.
- Keith will run a full pre-grid area as per previous years. Riders are to be gridded in this area under the direction of the pre-grid Officials, then will be directed to the start line.
