SIGN ON

All competitors will be required to sign an indemnity form (Parent or Guardian if under 18 years) and must have and present a current MA National Junior (also JCP Logbook) or Senior National license and proof of current club membership or have pre organised MA One event License.

CAMPING

Camping will be available from 11am Saturday 28th April in the areas surrounding the main pit area until Sunday morning. **Fires will not be permitted.** Fire ban season has been extended in the Mid North District.

ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A MIN 2KG FIRE EXTINGUISHER AVAILABLE TO THEM IN THEIR PIT TENT. IF SHARING A PIT TENT WITH ANOTHER RIDER THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 1 FIRE EXTINGUISHER PER TENT

SCRUTINEERING

All riders must present to rider sign on BEFORE machine examination. You will need to present your MA licence for inspection, excuses or photos will not be accepted. If you are unable to present your MA licence, you will forfeit your entry to the event, Junior riders must present their logbooks. All under 18 riders without a parent present will have to provide a signed Guardianship form to the Race Secretary before the event. Machines must comply with the MOMS requirements and the series Supplementary regulations including (bike helmet & boots must be presented). An event specific decal will be placed on the machine and helmet as they pass through Scrutineering NO sticker =No race. At machine examination you will need to be present

TRANSPONDER ZIP ON TAGS

Courses times will be recorded by transponder zip on tags. Each rider will need to purchase (once of purchase) a transponder for \$10.00, in the event the new transponder fails or needs to be replaced it will be replaced at no cost to the rider. If a rider loses the transponder tag then a new one can be purchased for \$10. After rider sign on and before Machine examination you are to collect your transponder from the timing tent. To ensure there are no delays to the days schedule please bring the correct money with you.

Riders are encouraged to bring their zip on tag from previous years.

Note: any competitors not at the venue by the close of Sign On will be charged to enter at the gate and possibly not permitted to race the event.

TRANSPONDER STICK ON TAGS

ALL stick on tags from previous years **MUST** be removed. A new stick on tag will be provided free of charge.

WALKING OF TRACKS

All riders may walk the course after 11.00am Saturday. There will be signs to direct rider to the relevant Junior and Senior tracks.

PARKING

All cars and pit tents to be on the paddock entrance side of the Pit lane, unless directed by the Clerk of course. No Cars to be on the north/west side of the track at any time.

PONY EXPRESS – riders **MUST** pit on the southern end of the pits please look for signs.

GOGGLE TEAR OFFS are not permitted to be used at this event as per of the 2018 MOMS General Competition Rules.

REFUELLING

Environments as per MOMS must be used when replenishing any fluids, penalties will apply for noncompliance. Refuelling only in designated refuelling area. All riders must dismount from the bike before refuelling and engine must be turned off. Environments can be purchased for \$10 at sign in.

No compulsory Refuelling

SOUND TESTING

Sound testing will take place as per the MOMS. If any rider is sound tested at the completion of the event, and fails the sound test they may be penalised by relegation of class position or excluded as per MOMS.

DOGS & FOOTWEAR

Please note: NO Animals or mini bikes (except those entered and human aid dogs) are not permitted at the event. NO open footwear.

CATERING

Excellent quality Catering will be available on Sunday, provided by Clare MCC, and a coffee van will be in attendance.

RIDERS BRIEFING

All riders (including a parent or guardian if under 18 years) must attend, there will be a random roll call.

FORMAT

Sunday 29th April will be a cross Country, in three separate races, of the duration below.

Race 1 – Juniors J1 & JJ – 1.5 hrs including sight lap

Race 2 – Juniors J2, J3, J4 – 2 hrs including sight lap

Race 3 – Seniors – Sight lap then a designated number of laps totalling up to 3hrs

COURSE SIZE AND TERRAIN

Juniors J1, JJ - 4.5 kms

Juniors J2, J3, J4 – 10 kms

Seniors – 14kms

TERRAIN

The J1 JJ track consists of open flowing track with a section following the Wakefield River

The J2, J3, J4 course consists of open flowing natural terrain grass track with a section of rocky trails thru the hills, two river crossings and some logs

The Seniors course consists of the same open flowing natural terrain grass track sections with additional rocky trails thru the hills and some logs.

The rocky trail sections have been swept with a rock rake, with the majority of surface rocks removed. There are still rocks present, and riders will need to ride to the conditions and stay on the marked track. Deviation from the marked course will increase the risk of hitting rocks immensely.

LOCATION

Plew Rd Woolshed Flat (AUBURN)

Turn left onto Long Rd approx. 8kms North of Rhynie if travelling North from Adelaide

Turn Right onto Long Rd approx. 6 kms South of Auburn if travelling South from Clare

Travel 2.2.kms along Long Rd and turn right onto Plew Rd

Travel 2.5 kms along Plew Rd and turn into gateway on right. Plew Road is narrow and windy. Please exercise caution and watch out for oncoming traffic.

8.00 am (approx.) Race 1 - JJ & J1 riders will be lead out by a sweep rider and with a sweep rider behind them.

Sighting lap – After the **leading** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 8 minutes (No exceptions)

There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.

Start race with JJ & J1 Riders lined up in a Single Row - Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars

ALL riders must stop for an injured rider and send the next rider back to notify the medical team.

09.30 - Race Finish

09.30 - 09.45 am - Sweep Course

9.45am (approx.) Race 2- J2, J3, J4 riders will be lead out by a sweep rider and with a sweep rider behind them.

Sighting lap – – After the **leading** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 8 minutes (No exceptions)

There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.

ALL riders must stop for an injured rider and send the next rider back to notify the medical team.

START RACE - Start one Row at a time with 1 Minute between Rows Starting

1st Row - J4 & J3 Riders lined up in a Single Row – Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars

2nd Row – J2 Riders lined up in a Single Row – Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars

11.45 - Race Finish

11.45 to 12.00 - Sweep Course

11.00am Seniors riders Briefing

12.15 to 12.30 pm - All **SENIORS will be** lead out by a sweep rider with sweeps following up

Notice to all riders: the sight lap entry will close 10 mins after the lead sweep rider leaves, be ready for sight lap

There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.

After the **leading** sweep has completed the course including the pits the Pro & Expert race will start in 15 minutes (No exceptions)

Race Start – 12.45 to 3.45

ALL riders must stop for an injured rider and send the next rider back to notify the medical team.

Note – Dead Engine Start with Riders lined up in Single Rows – Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars

START RACE - Start one Row at a time with 1 Minute between Rows Starting

1st Row PRO/Expert

2nd Row C3

3rd Row C2

4th Row C1

5th Row Vet

6th Row Mas/Women

7th Row Pony Express

Pony Express riders will have a separate pit/ changeover area, located near the scores tent. See attached map.
